Auto Dimming is a state of the art feature that includes a sensor that gauges the amount of ambient light being reflected in the mirror and automatically adjusts the mirror to reduce the glare from the mirror to your eyes.


This product uses the most advanced technology and components to provide you with a long service life and integrates perfectly with the factory look of your vehicle to add a high level of safety and security to your driving experience.

Designed to replace the original rear view mirror of your vehicle, Parkmate's Auto Dimming RVM-043ATD Mirror Monitor features a high resolution 4.3" LCD panel embedded into the mirror that captures the area not visible to standard rear-view mirrors when fitted with an optional Parkmate rear view camera.

WIRING OPTIONS



Connect the Rear View Mirror Monitor to the supplied harness and the supplied harness to the wiring of the car as instructed in the below image:

PLEASE NOTE: CAMERA IS NOT SUPPLIED. IF YOU HAVE PURCHASED A REVERSE CAMERA PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS THAT WERE SUPPLIED WITH THE CAMERA AS THE ABOVE IMAGE IS ONLY A GUIDE.

- When the rear view mirror is "Powered-On" and the reverse gear is engaged, the system automatically switches from video source (i.e. if there are 2 video sources in use) to reverse camera video. When reverse gear is disengaged the system switches back automatically.
- 2. When the rear view mirror is "Powered-Off" and the reverse gear is engaged, the system automatically switches to the camera signal and displays reverse camera video. When reverse gear is disengaged the system switches off automatically.

- 3. The button in the middle of the rear view mirror is the POWER button.
 - a) When reverse is engaged or when in camera mode press the POWER button to adjust the back-light of the monitor.
 - b) When the monitor is in video mode, the POWER button is used to turn the monitor on and off

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE OF MIRROR MONITOR

- The Mirror monitor is made of glass. Do not subject it to a mechanical shock by dropping it from a high place, etc.
- Do not apply excessive force to the monitor surface or to the adjoining areas as this may cause the colour tone to vary.
- 3. Do not attempt to disassemble the mirror monitor. Doing so will void all warranties.
- 4. When cleaning the mirror monitor, spray glass cleaner directly onto a paper towel or similar material. Do not spray glass cleaner directly onto the mirror monitor as this can result in damage to circuitry. Clean residue with a soft dry cloth.

SAFFTY

- A rear view camera display is only a visual assistance device when reversing the vehicle.
 Images displayed on the screen may be different from actual conditions. Always physically inspect conditions and drive carefully.
- 2. Reverse your vehicle as slow as possible. High speeds can limit your reaction time to stop your vehicle.
- The displayable range of input devices including cameras can vary depending on vehicle loads and road conditions.
- 4. Do not use a rear view camera system with the tailgate open.
- Objects under or around the bumper cannot be displayed when the system is used with a rear view camera.
