



Quick Start Information:

1. Plug the BAS950BT into the power point.
2. Insert the red and white RCA cables into the corresponding TV input sockets in the BAS950BT.
3. Insert the opposite ends of red and white RCA cables into the corresponding TV output sockets in your TV.
4. Turn the subwoofer power on via the power switch on the back of the subwoofer
5. Press the Standby button on top of the sound bar or on the remote control to turn the BAS950BT on.
6. Make sure your TV is switched on and that your BAS950BT is set to TV input to hear TV audio through your new sound bar.
7. To change the input source between Bluetooth/TV/AUX/USB modes use the Input button.
8. Enjoy your new Bush BAS950BT sound bar.

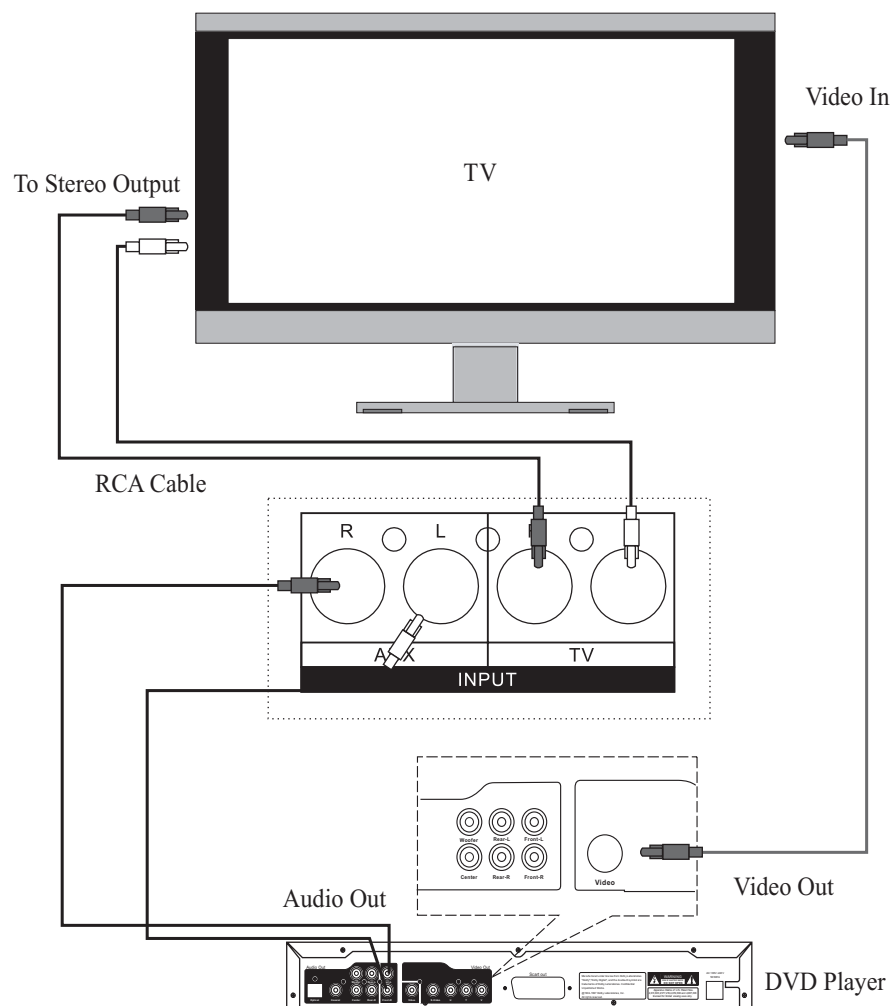

Safety Precautions

If the subwoofer is not linking properly with the soundbar or there is no sound coming from the subwoofer please follow the below steps:

- 1) Press the "STANDBY" button on soundbar or on the remote control, and switch off the subwoofer.
- 2) Press the "STANDBY" button on soundbar or on the remote control again, the soundbar gets into play-mode. And then switch on the subwoofer within 15 seconds after you pressed "STANDBY". After 15 seconds the coding should be completed and the subwoofer will be connected to the soundbar wirelessly. (You can confirm this by the blue light on the front of the subwoofer. If the soundbar and subwoofer are connected the blue light will be solid but if it is flashing then the subwoofer and soundbar are not connected.)
- 3) Please repeat the above steps if the soundbar is not connecting to the subwoofer wirelessly.
- 4) Once the above steps have been completed and the soundbar is connected to the subwoofer the settings will automatically save and there should be no need to follow the above steps again unless the product is disconnected from the mains power.



Caution: Please read carefully all the following important safeguards to ensure safe operation.

1. Read Instructions - All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.
2. Retain Instructions - The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.

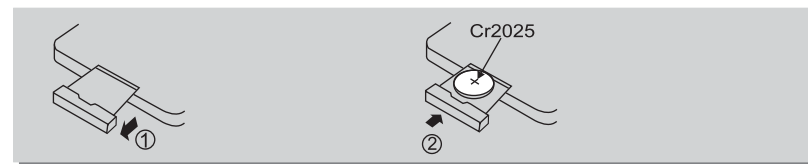
15. Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.

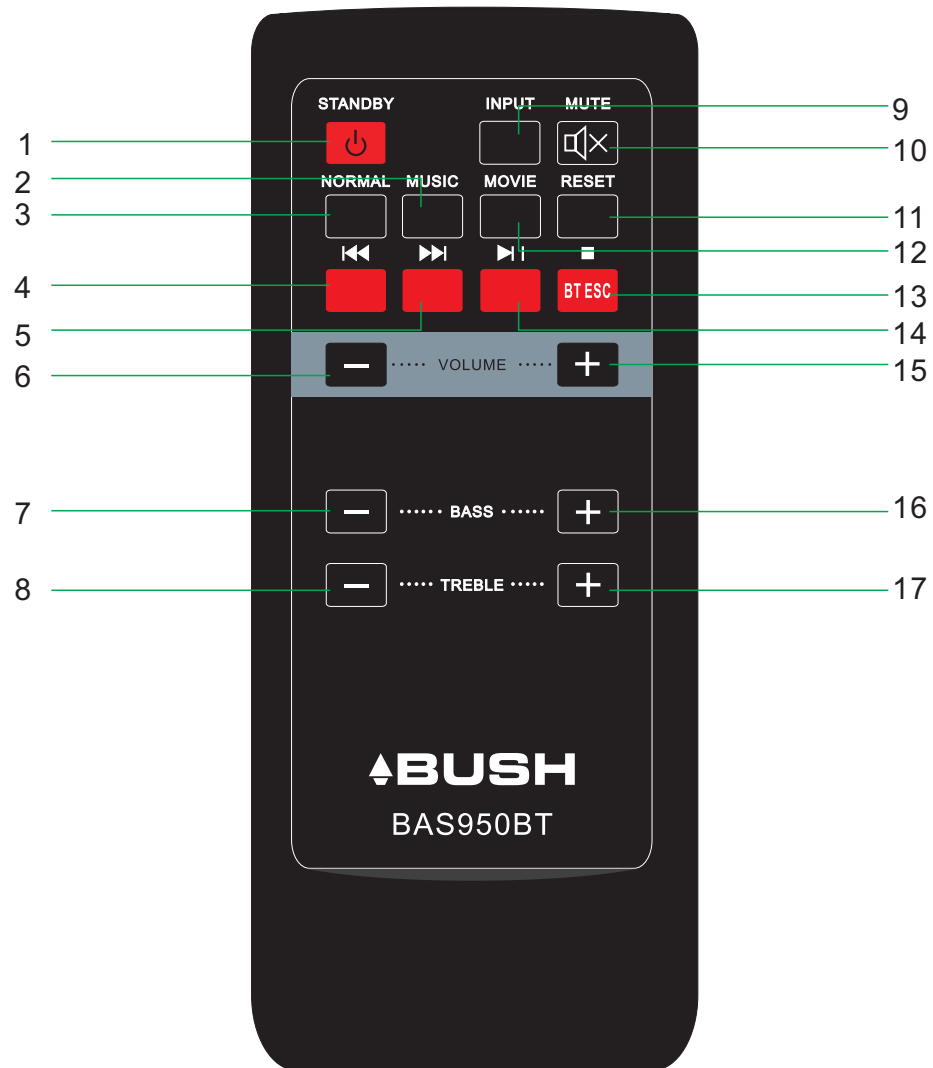

REMOTE CONTROL BATTERY REPLACEMENT

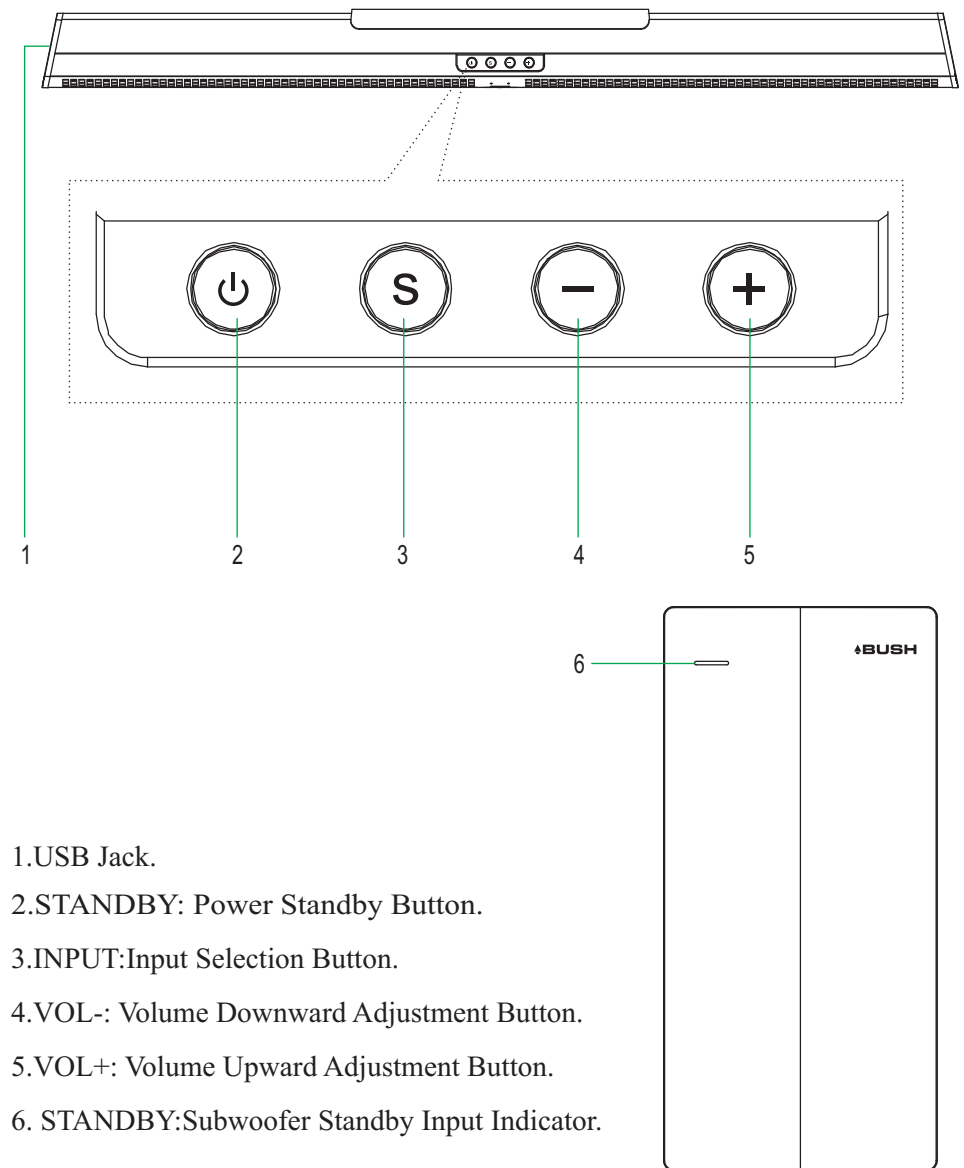
- 1.Replace the remote control battery when it no longer operates the unit, or the range is reduced considerably.
- 2.Use only Cr2025 3V lithium batteries
- 3.Bear in mind that lighting & other room conditions, in addition to battery age, can affect the operating range of an infrared remote control.

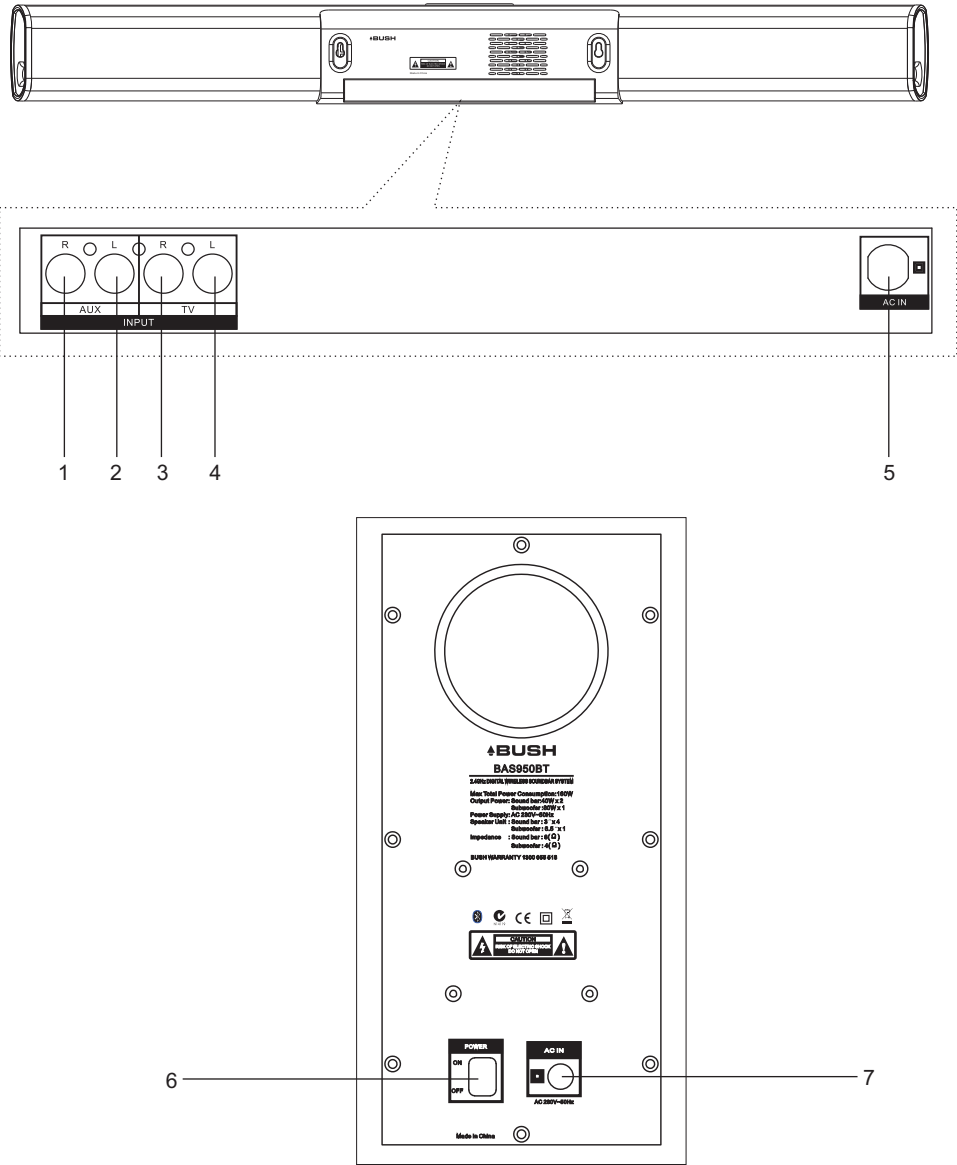


FRONT PANEL - CONTROLS AND FUNCTIONS
